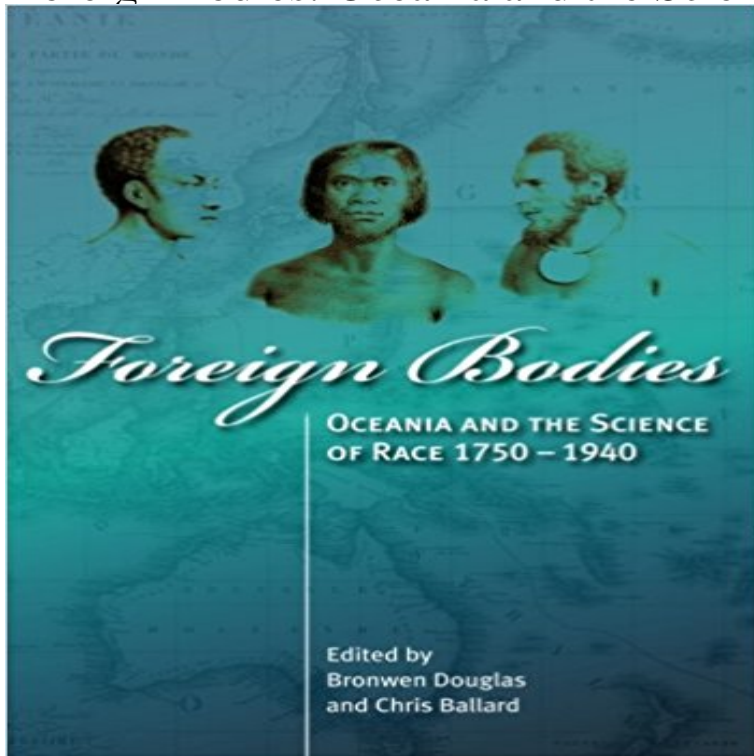


Foreign Bodies: Oceania and the Science of Race 1750-1940
