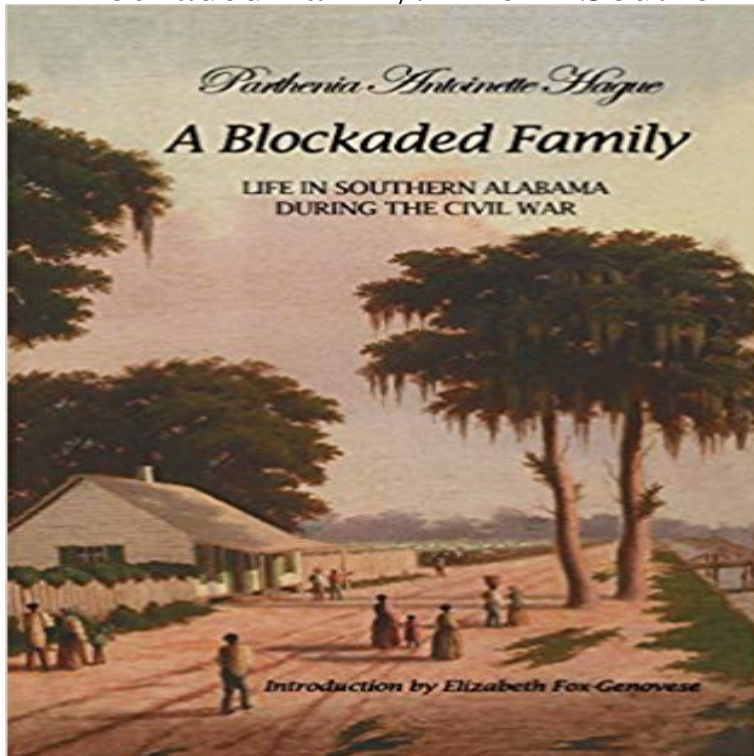


A Blockaded Family: Life in Southern Alabama During the Civil War
