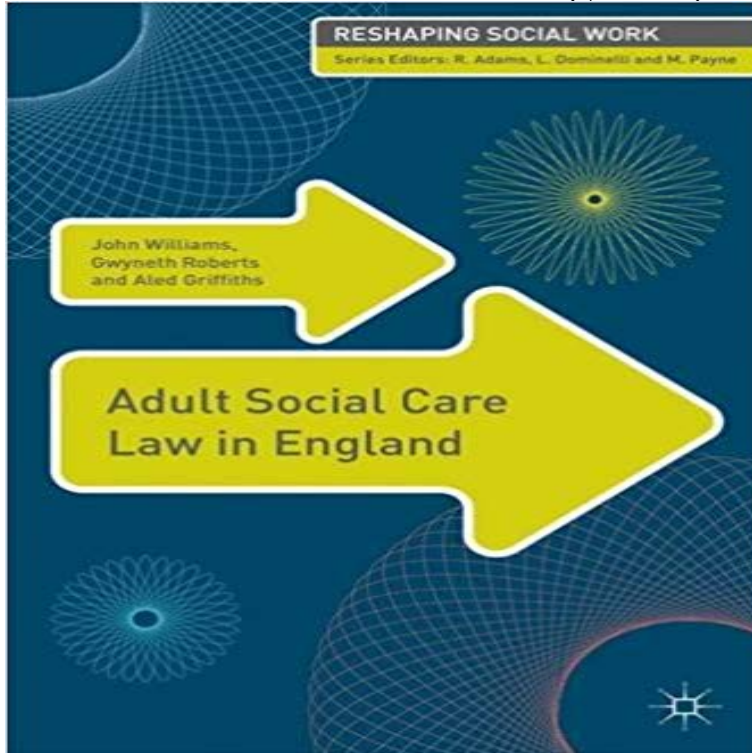


Adult Social Care Law in England (Reshaping Social Work)
