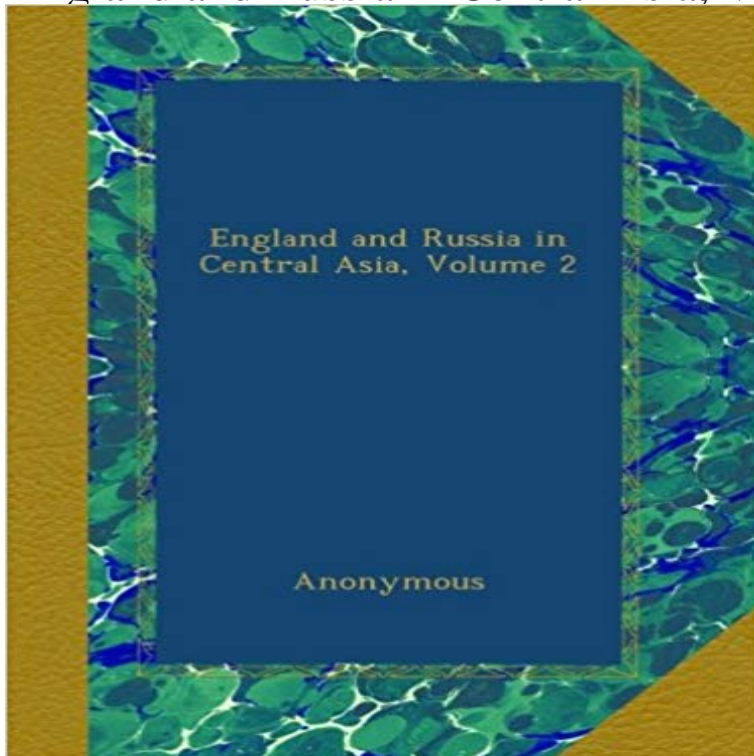


England and Russia in Central Asia, Volume 2
