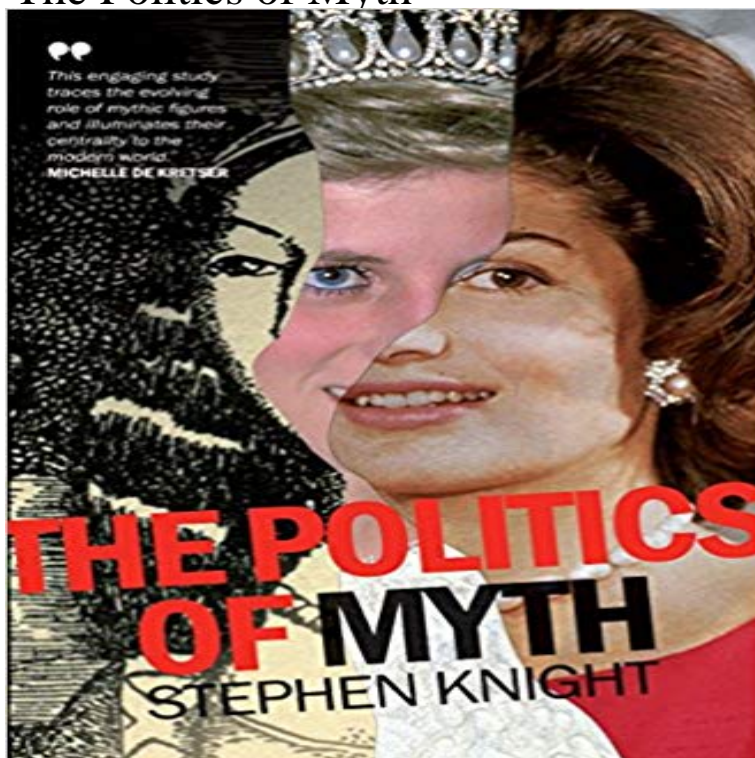


The Politics of Myth
