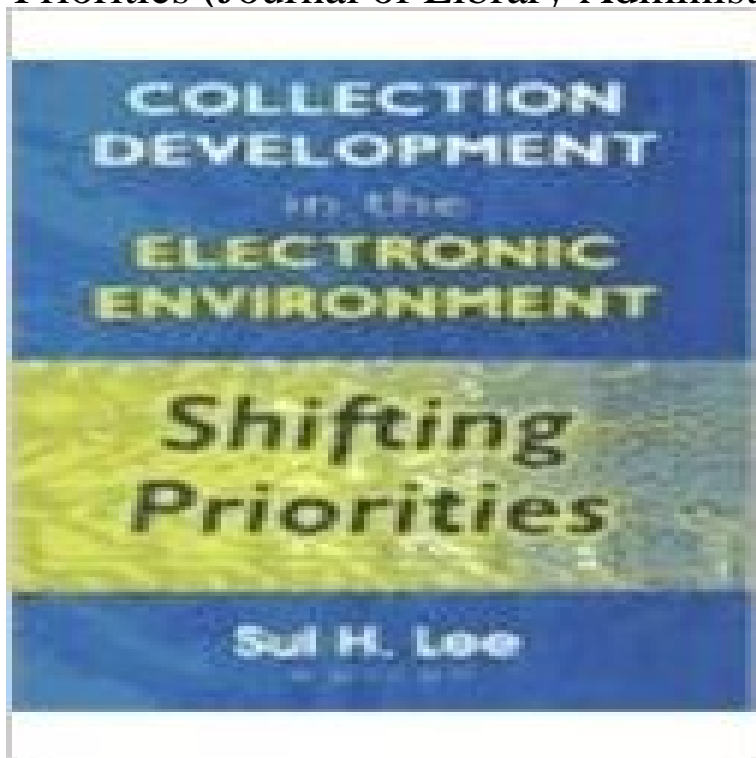


Collection Development in the Electronic Environment: Shifting Priorities (Journal of Library Administration (Paperback))
