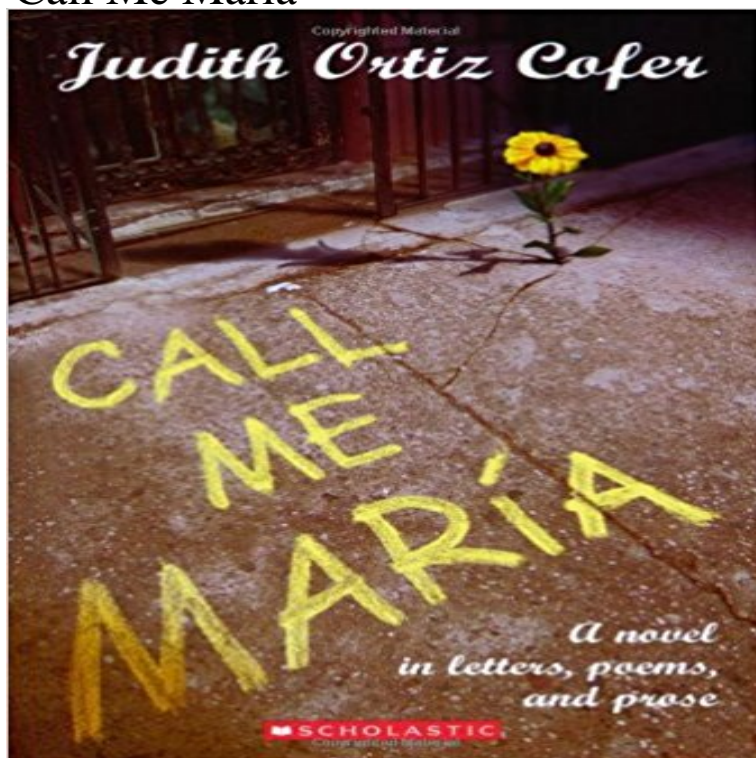


Call Me Maria
