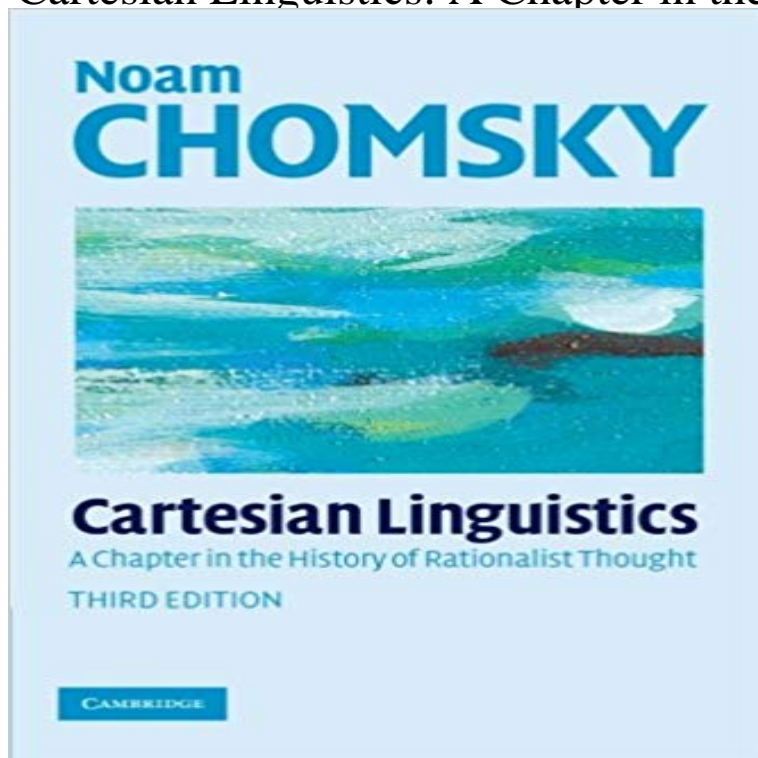


Cartesian Linguistics: A Chapter in the History of Rationalist Thought
