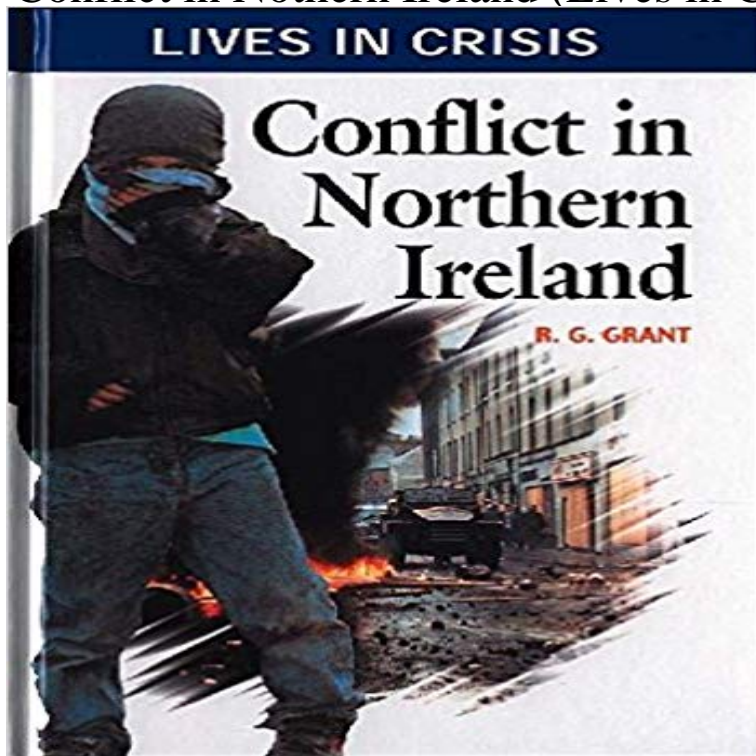


Conflict in Northern Ireland (Lives in Crisis)
