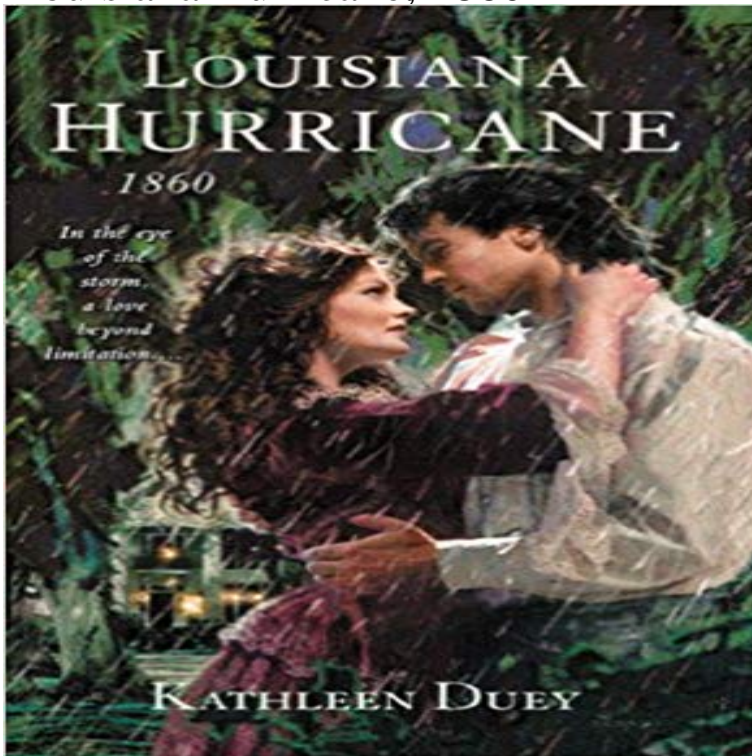


Louisiana Hurricane, 1860
