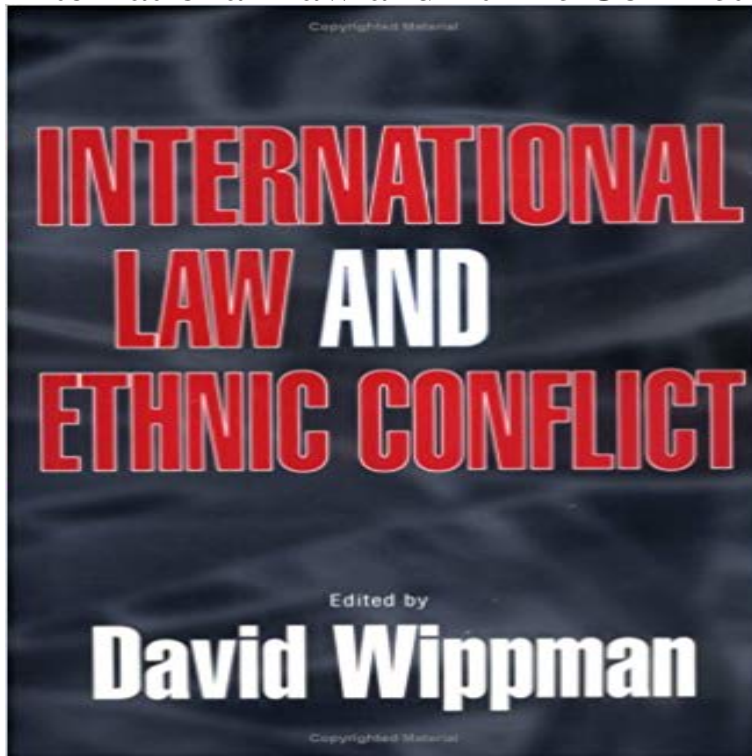


International Law and Ethnic Conflict
