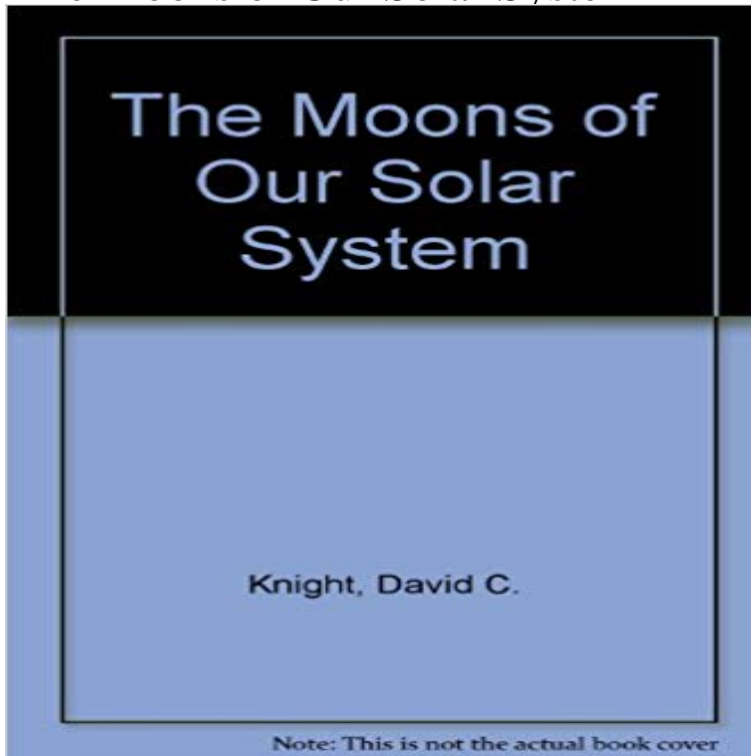


The Moons of Our Solar System
