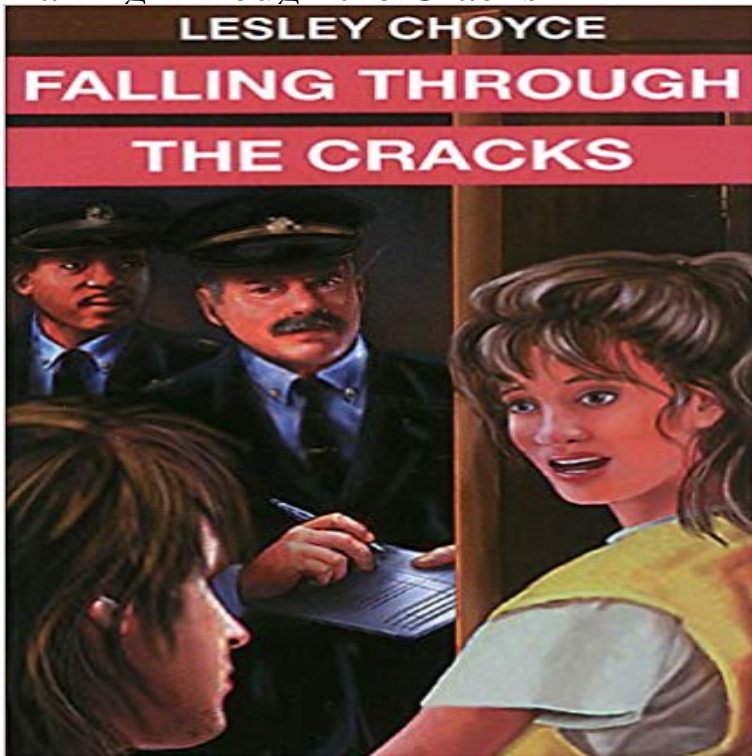


## Falling Through the Cracks

And when Trent starts disappearing mysteriously, reappearing with lots of cash, Melanie gets worried. Soon she finds herself fighting alone, fighting to stay alive. Set against the gritty background of inner-city Halifax, *Falling Through the Cracks* is a story about the difficulties faced by the young and dispossessed, and of the indifference they often face in their struggles to survive.
