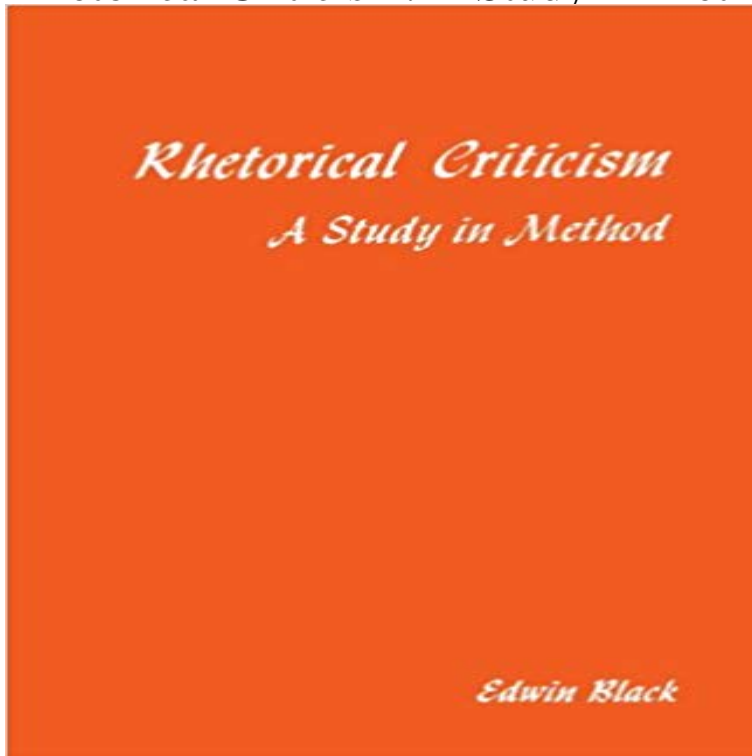


Rhetorical Criticism: A Study In Method
