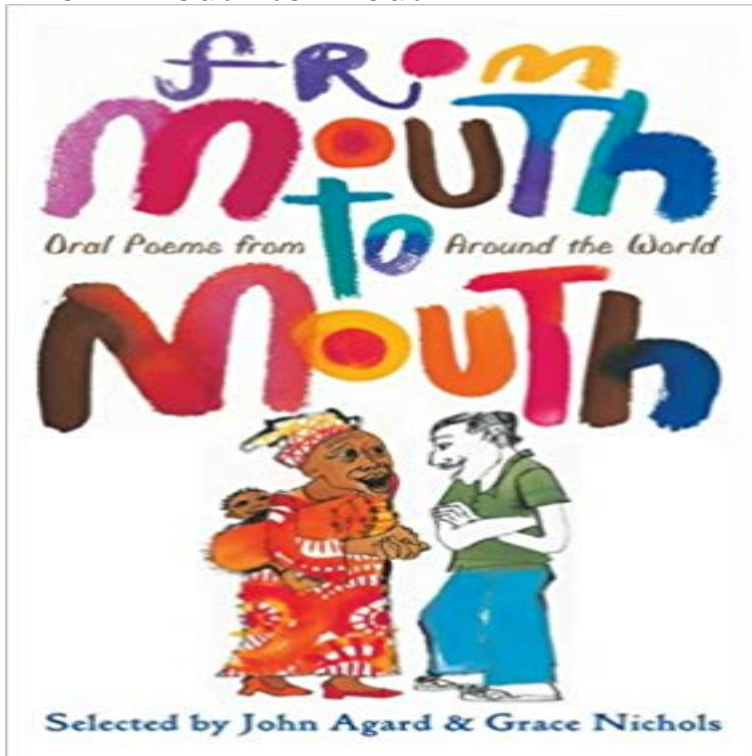


From Mouth to Mouth
