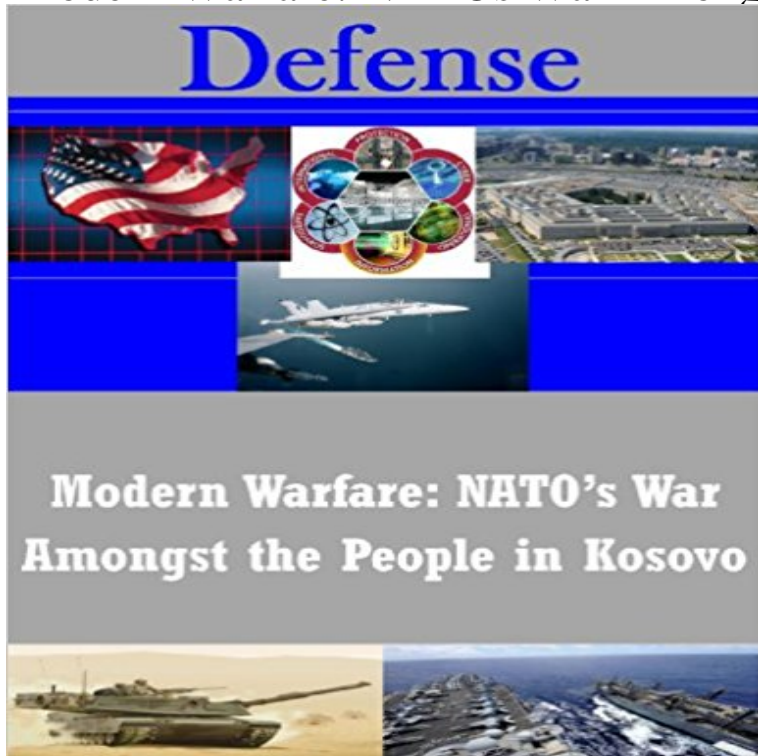


Modern Warfare: NATO's War Amongst the People in Kosovo
