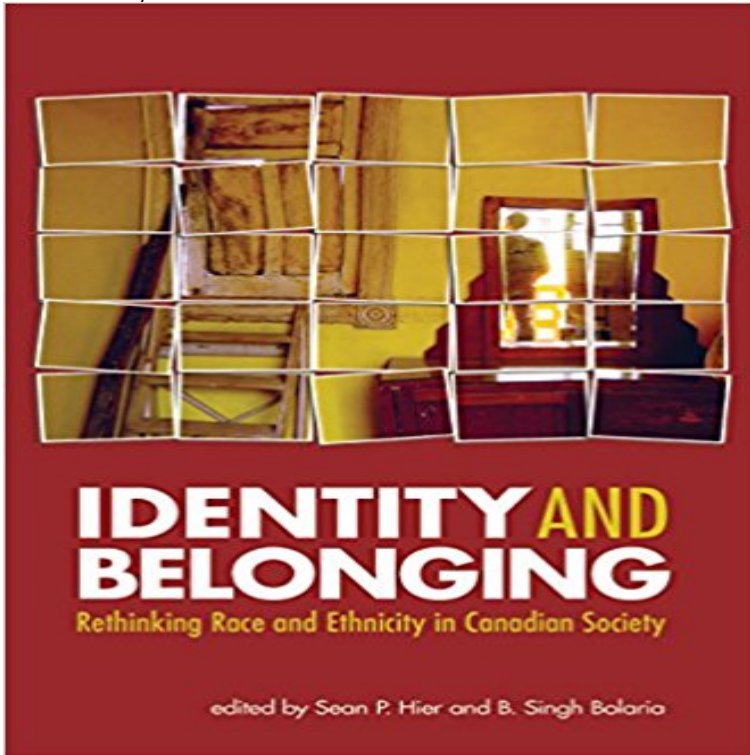


# Identity and Belonging: Rethinking Race and Ethnicity in Canadian Society
