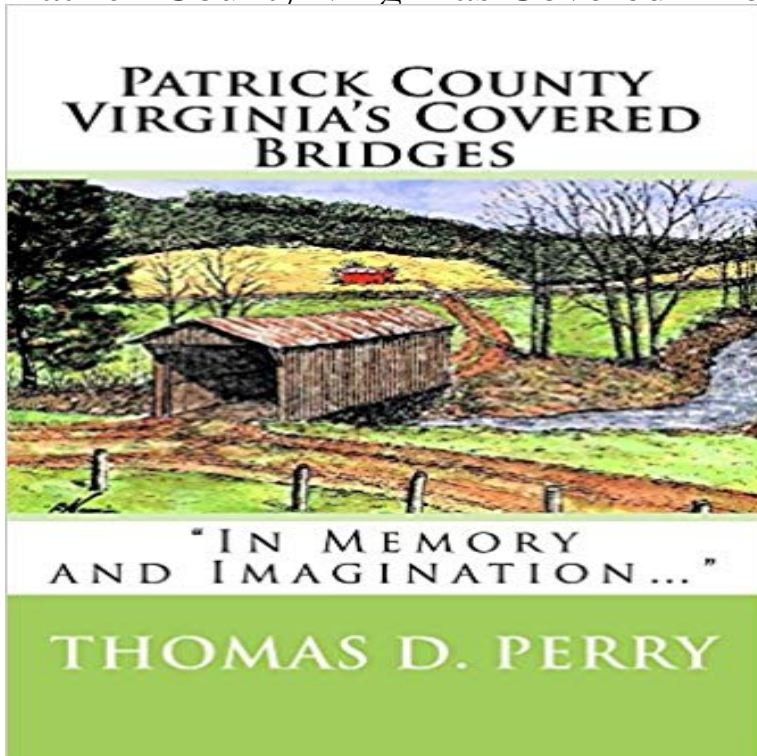


# Patrick County Virginias Covered Bridges
