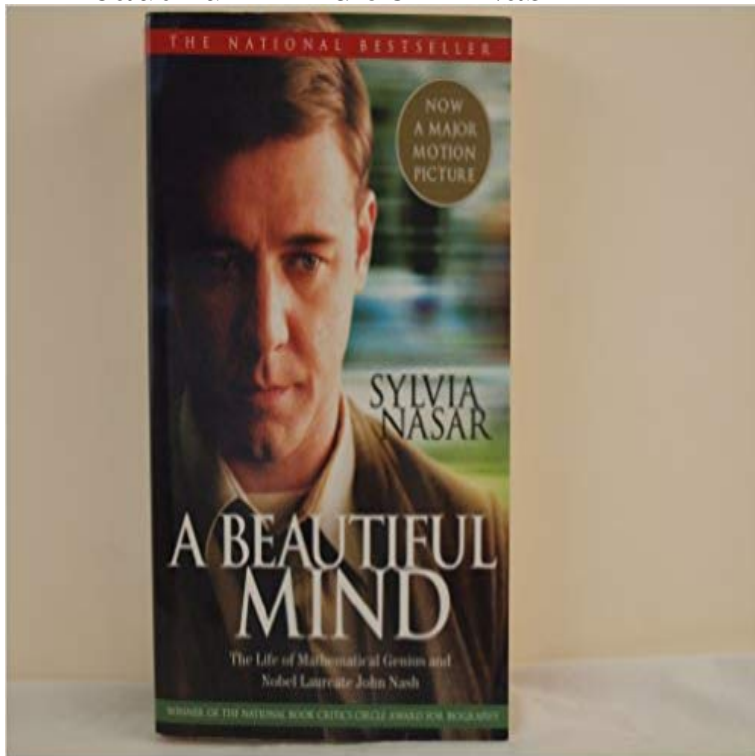


A Beautiful Mind John Nash
