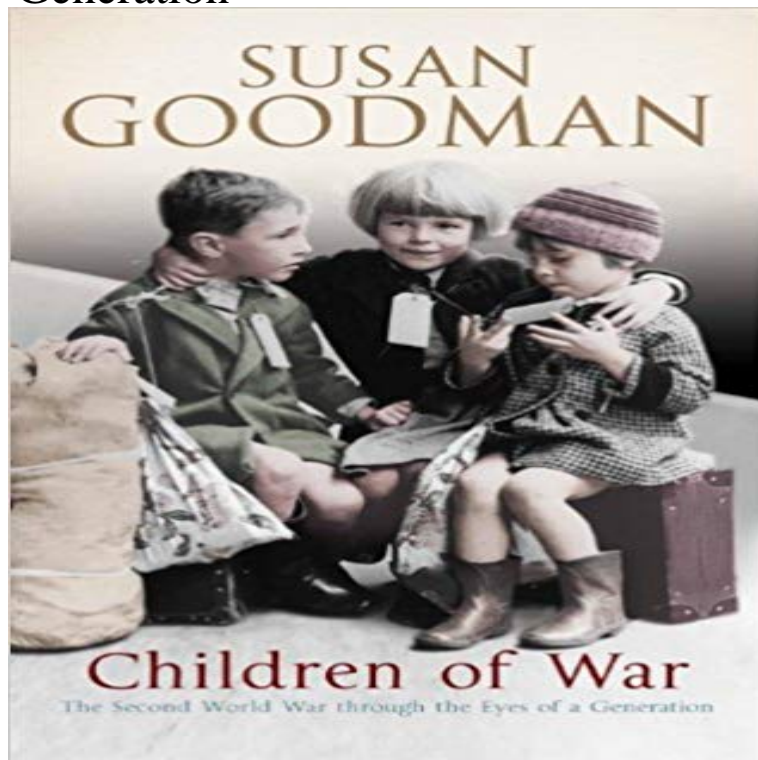


## Children of War: The Second World War Through the Eyes of a Generation
