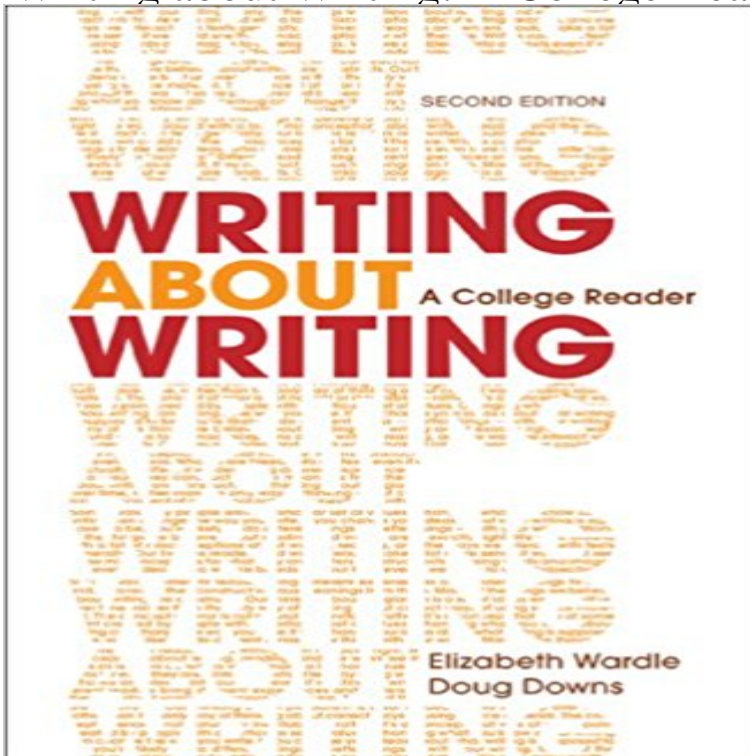


Writing about Writing: A College Reader
