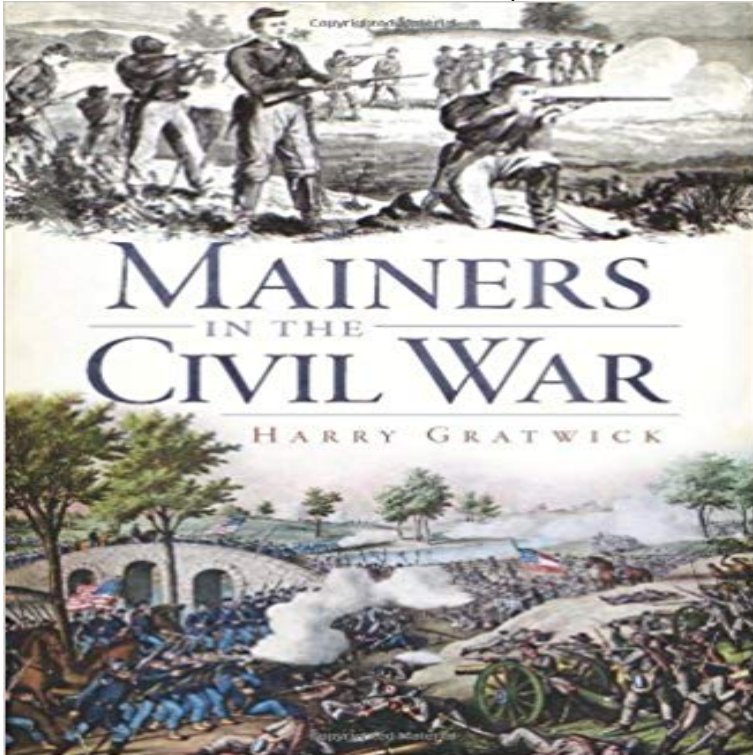


Mainers in the Civil War (Civil War Series)
