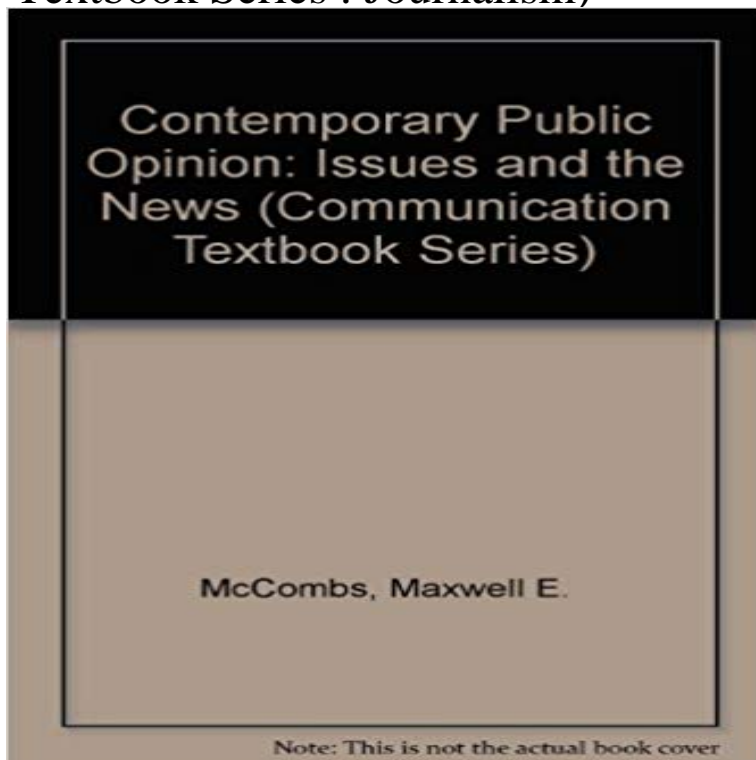


## Contemporary Public Opinion: Issues and the News (Communication Textbook Series : Journalism)
