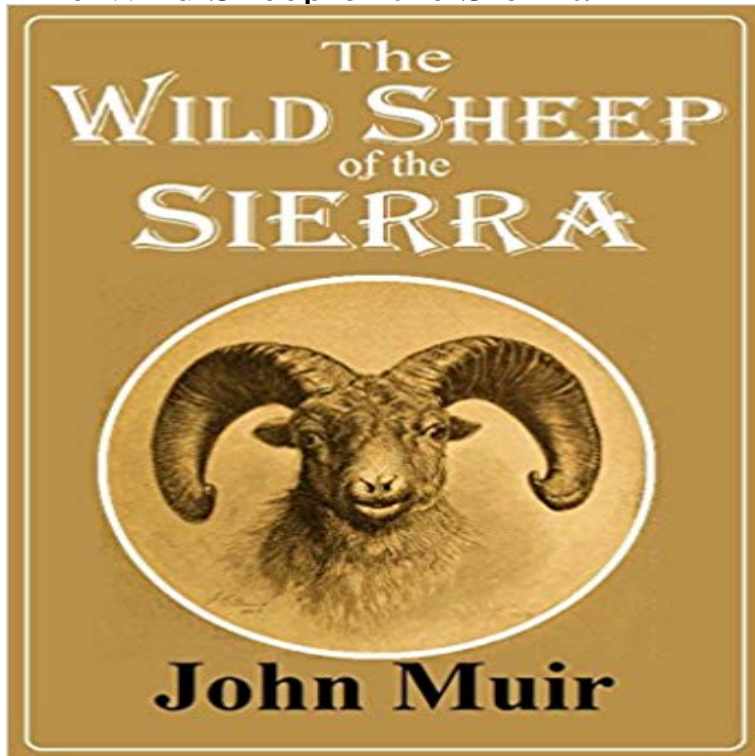


The Wild Sheep of the Sierra

His activism helped to preserve the Yosemite Valley, Sequoia National Park and other wilderness areas.
