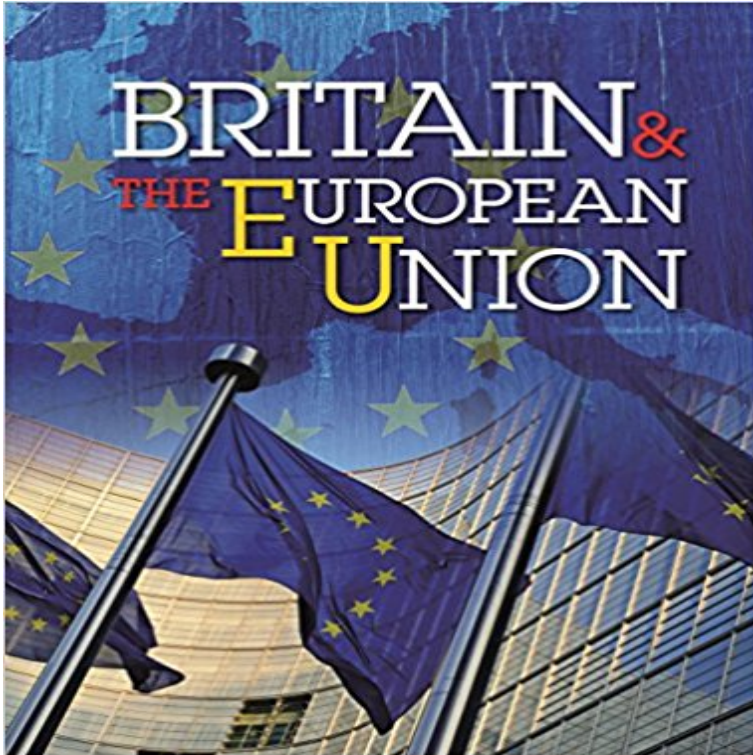


Britain and the EU
