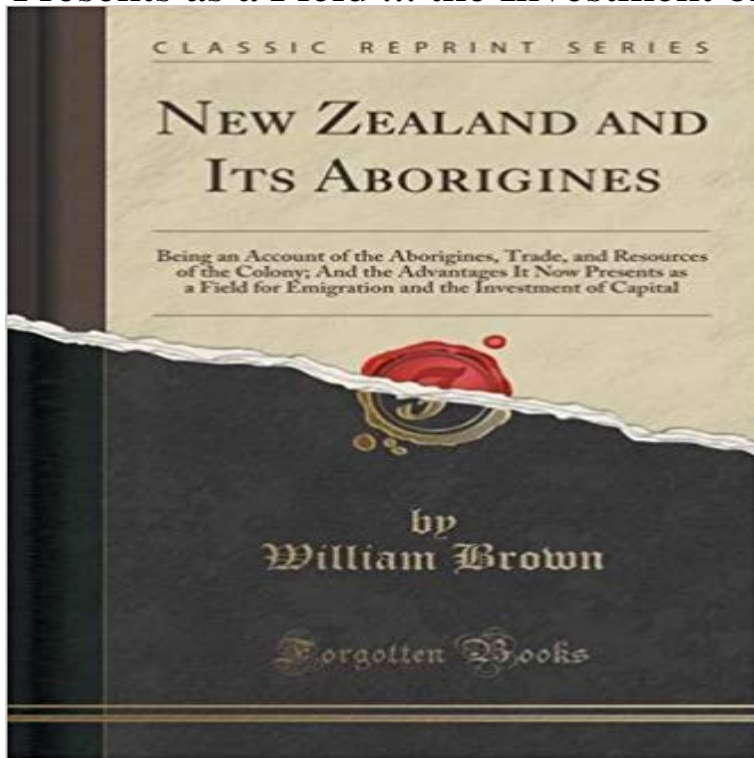

Like many other letters, however, from New Zealand, these never relied their destination; and other occupations prevented me from recurring to the subject until circumstances led me to re-visit Britain, when, to beguile a few of the tedious hours of a five months homeward voyage, I again transcribed my manuscript, believing that the information it affords may still be found useful, notwithstanding the number of works which have already been published on the same subject.
