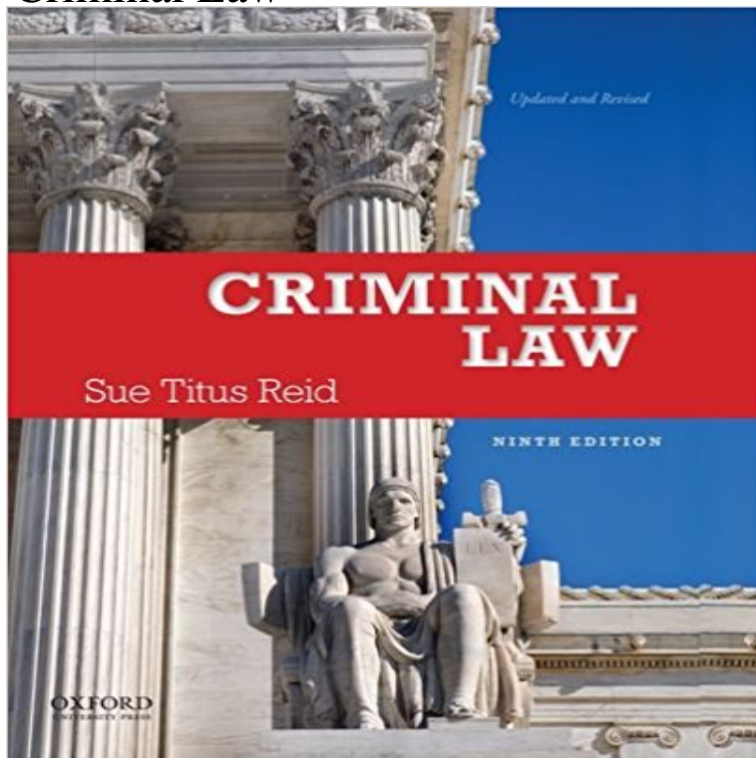


Criminal Law
