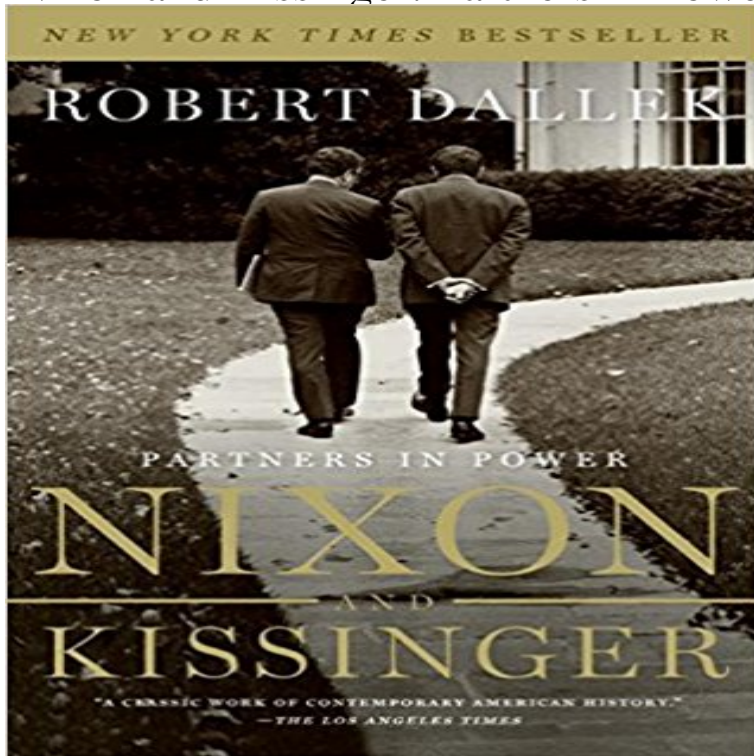


Nixon and Kissinger: Partners in Power
