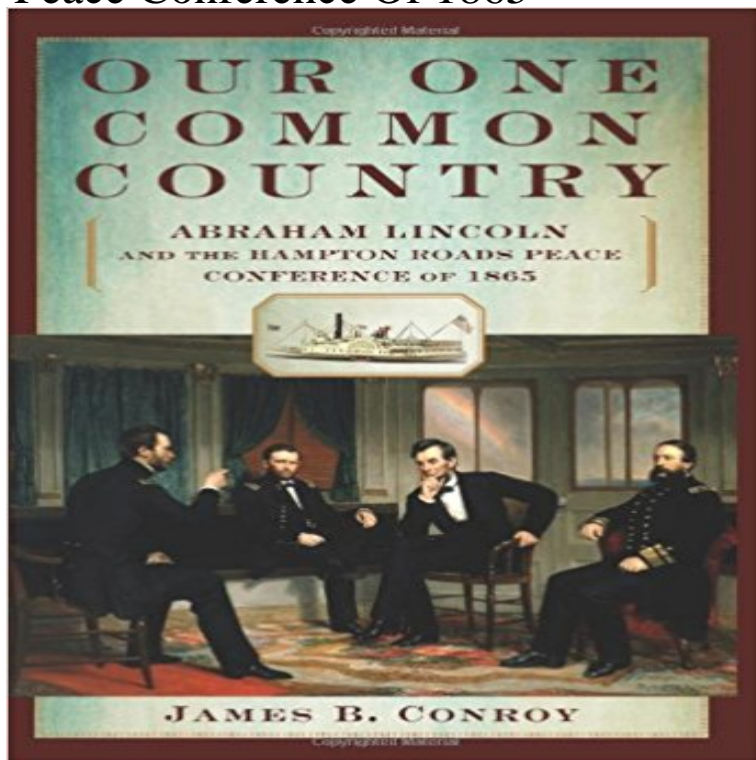


## Our One Common Country: Abraham Lincoln And The Hampton Roads Peace Conference Of 1865
