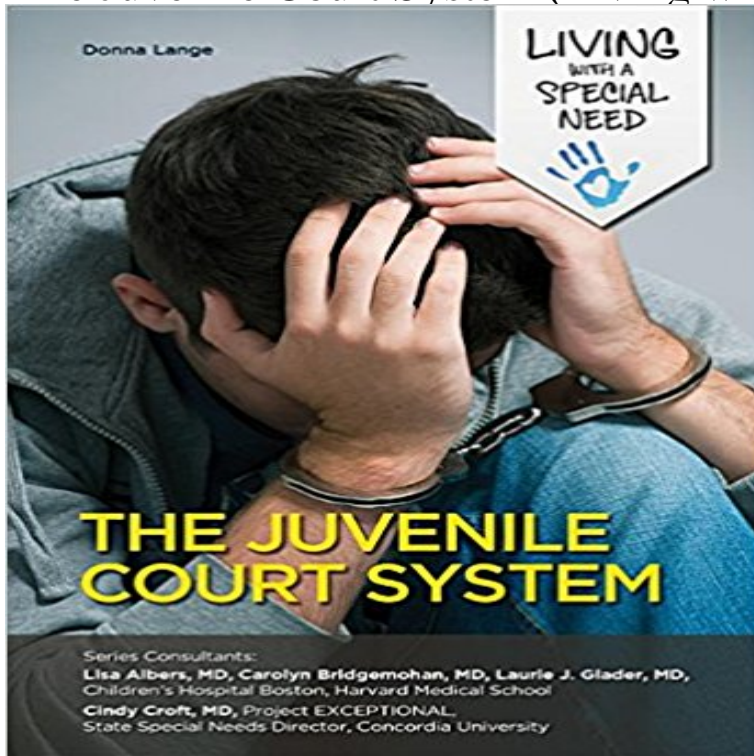


## The Juvenile Court System (Living with a Special Need)
