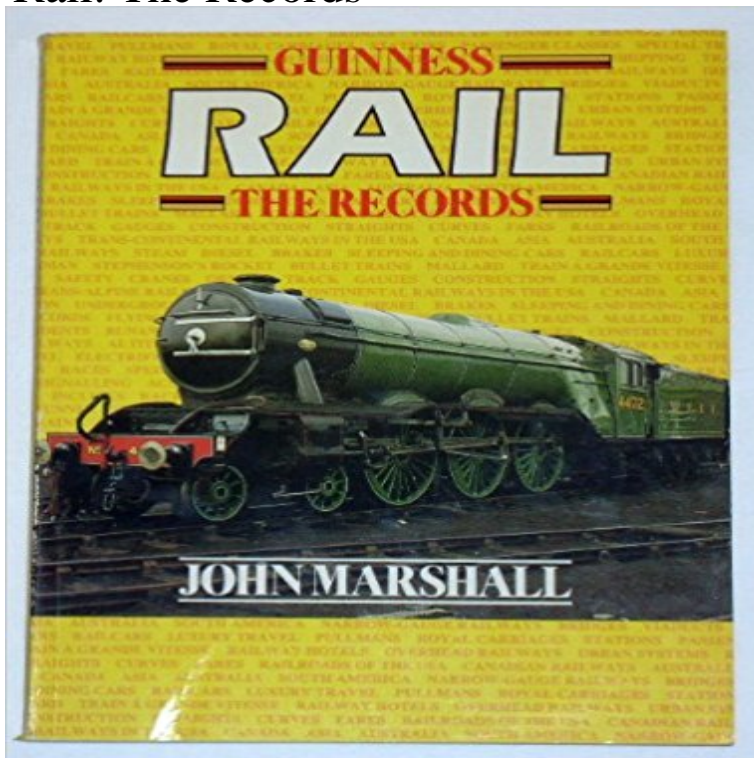


Rail: The Records
