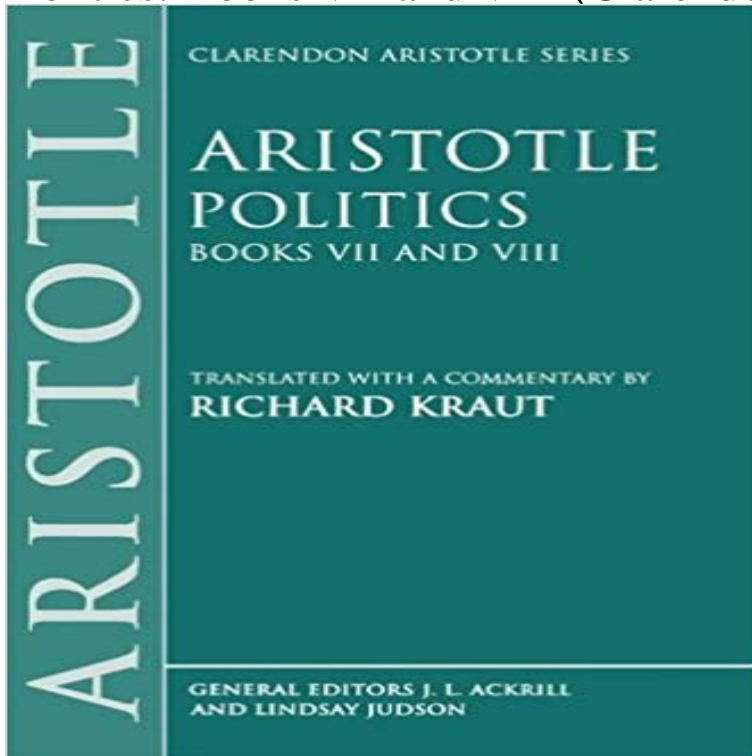


## Politics: Books VII and VIII (Clarendon Aristotle Series) (Bks.7 & 8)
