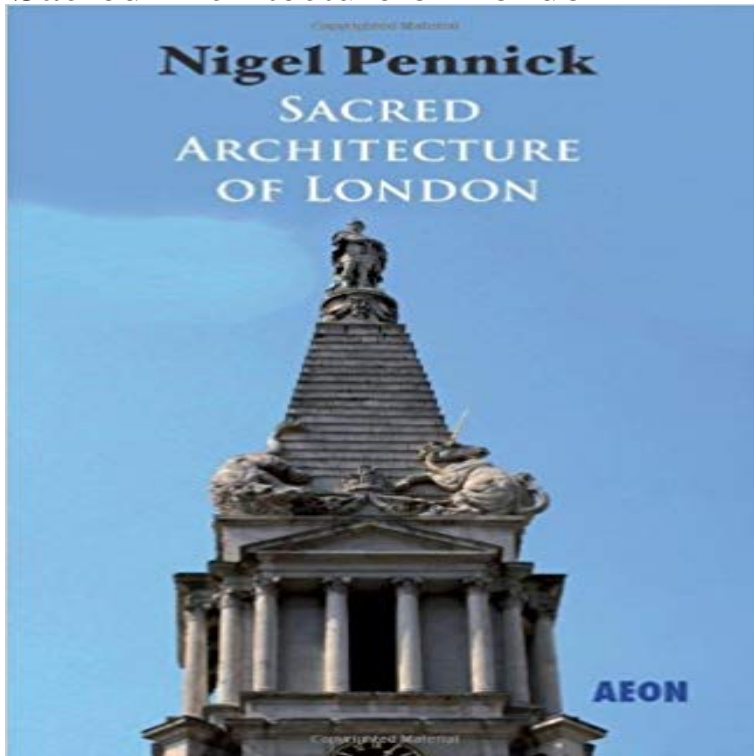


## Sacred Architecture of London
