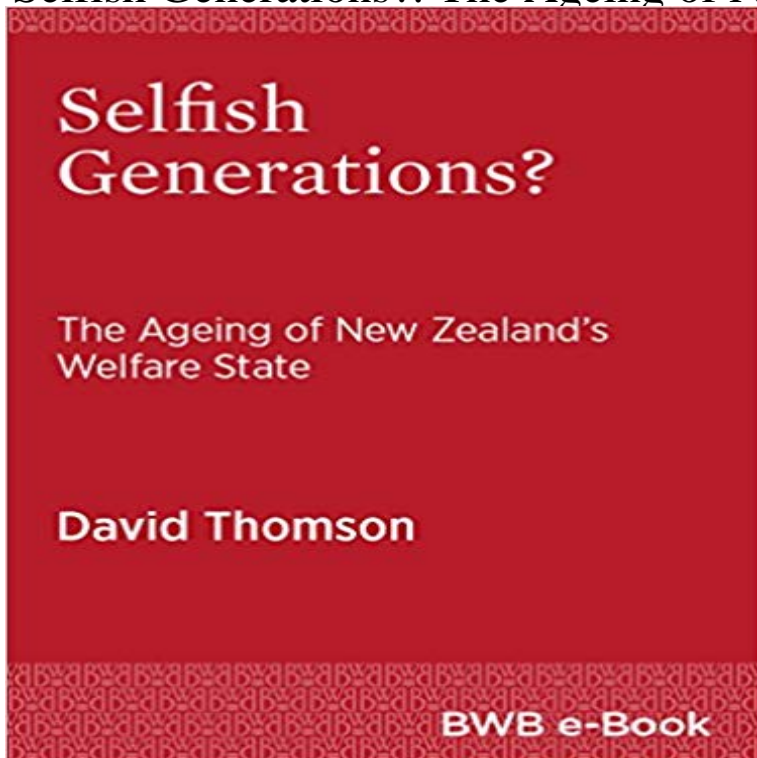


Selfish Generations?: The Ageing of New Zealand's Welfare State
