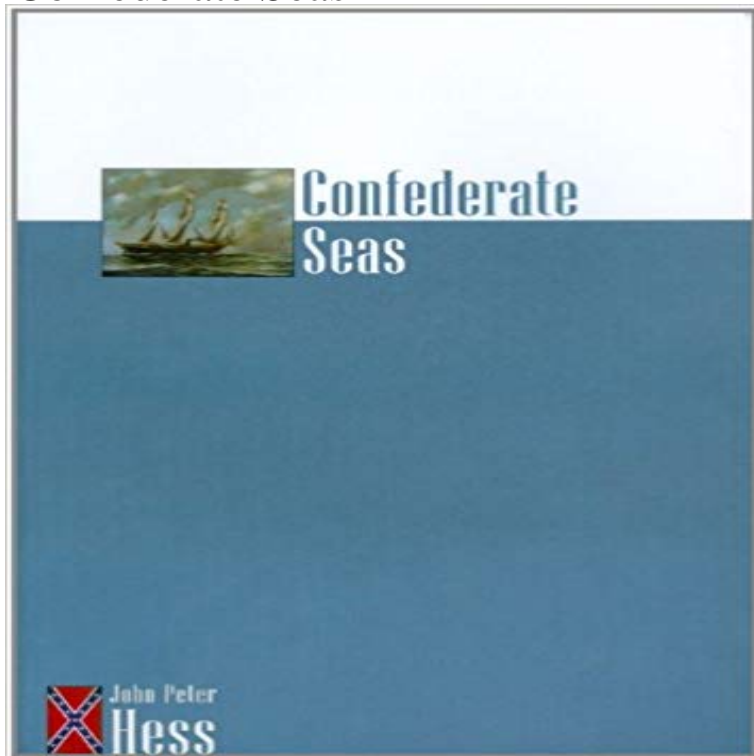


## Confederate Seas
