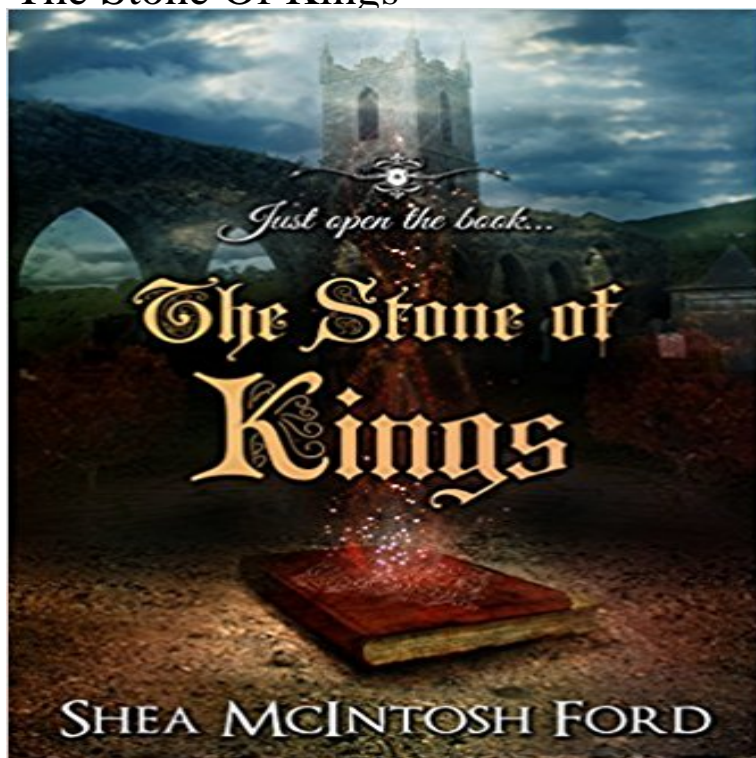


The Stone Of Kings
