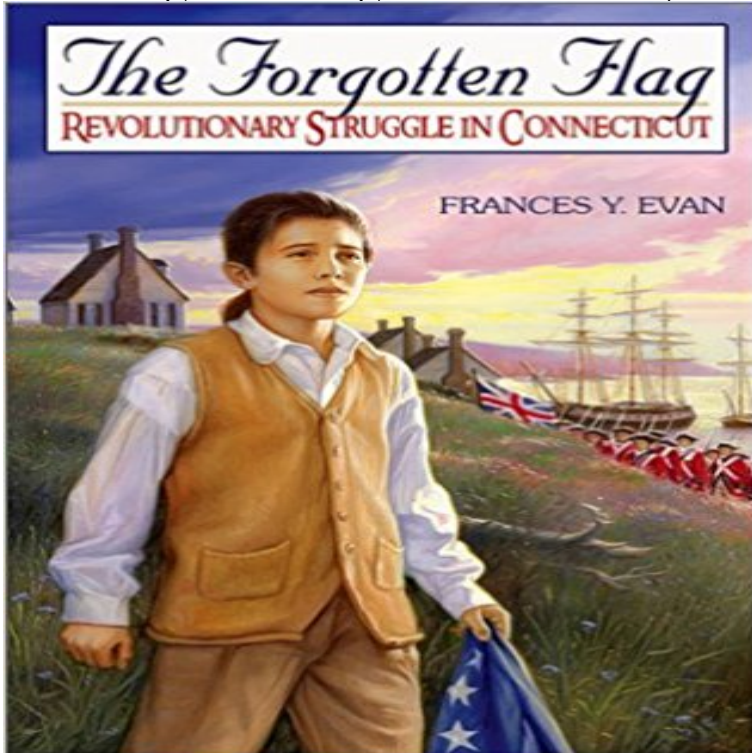


The Forgotten Flag: Revolutionary Struggle in Connecticut
