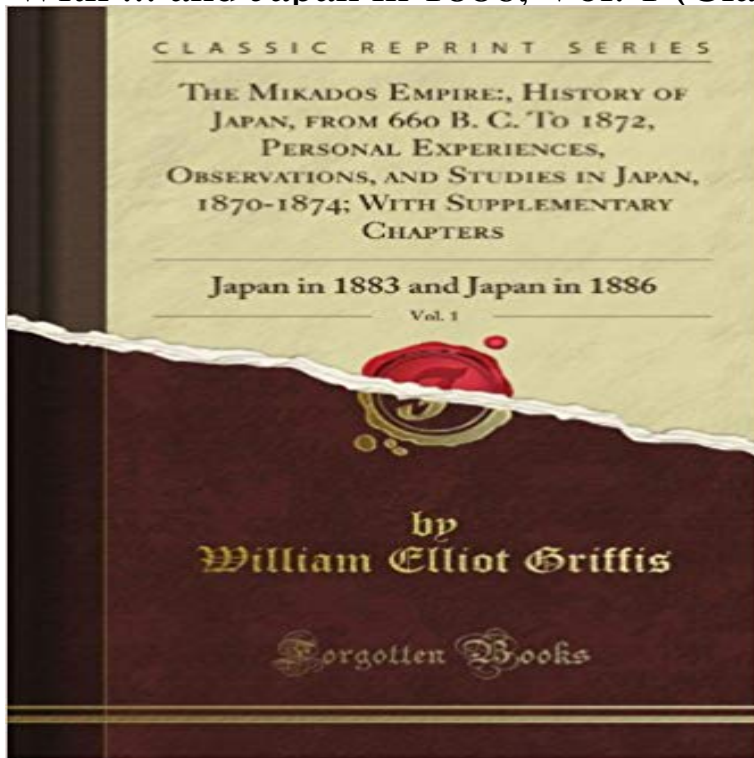

It is time to drop the license of exaggeration, and, with the light of common day, yet with sympathy and without prejudice, seek to know what Japan is and has been. It has been well said by a literary critic and reader of all the books on the subject that to write a good history of Japan is difficult, not so much from lack of materials, but from the differences in psychology. This I realize. My endeavor, during eight years living contact with these people, has been, from their language, books, life, and customs, to determine their mental parallax, and find out how they think and feel. I have not made this book in libraries at home, but largely on the soil of the Mikados Empire. I have slight obligation to acknowledge to foreign writers, except to those working scholars in Japan who have written during the last decade. With knowledge of the language.
