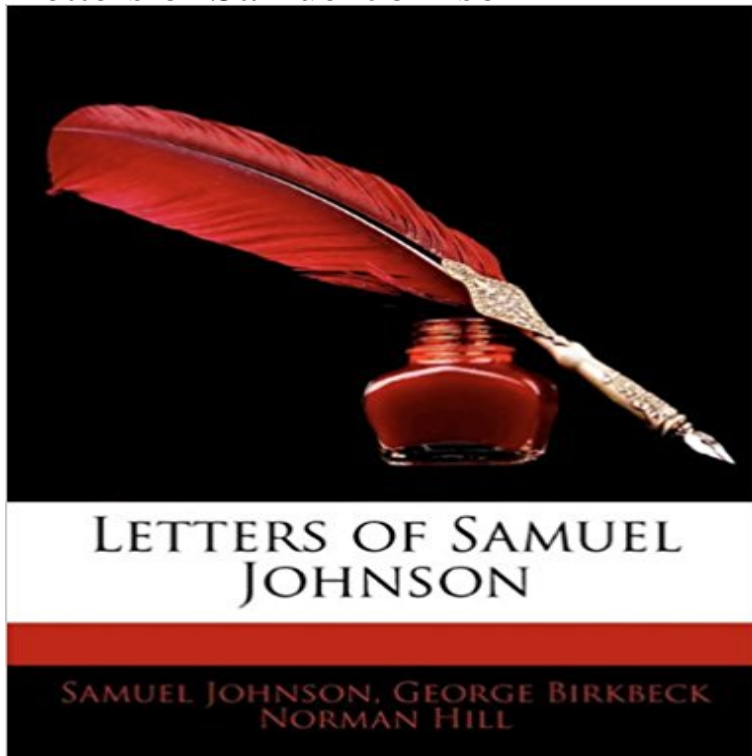


## Letters of Samuel Johnson
