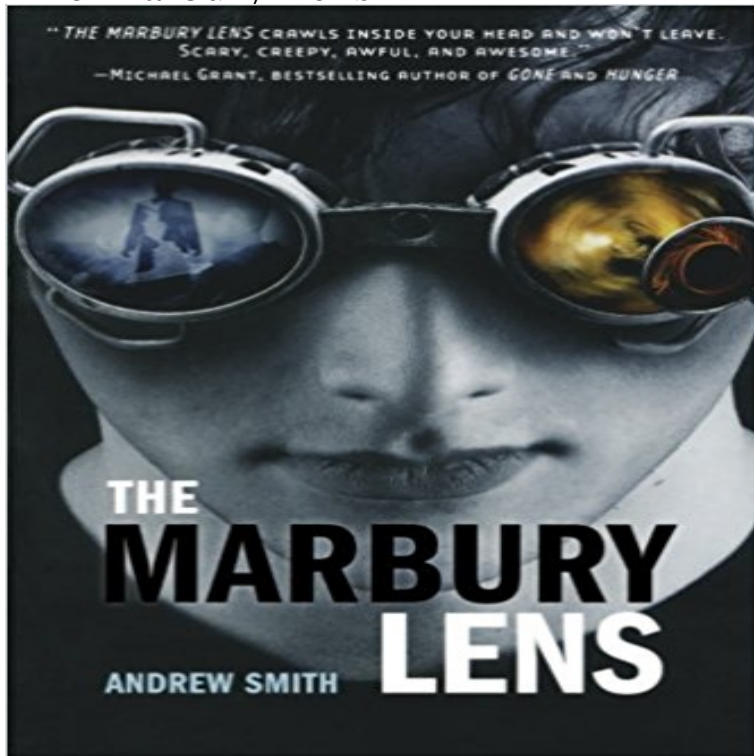


The Marbury Lens
