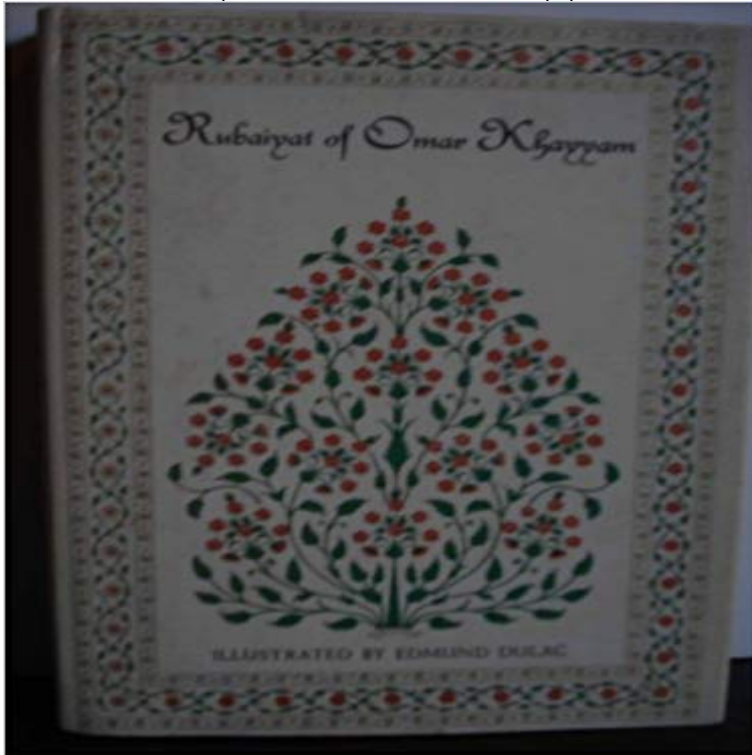


The Rubaiyat of Omar Khayyam
