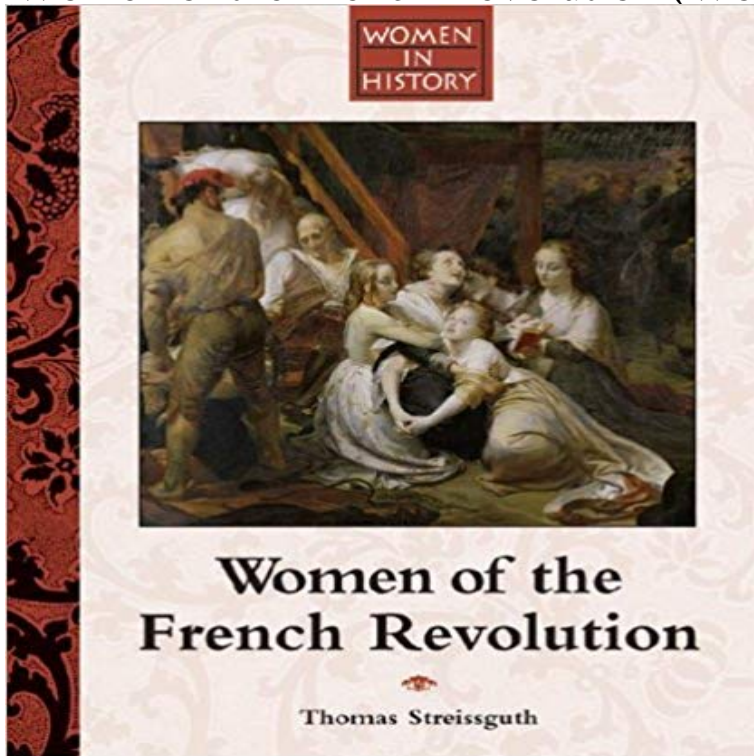


## Women of the French Revolution (Women in History)
