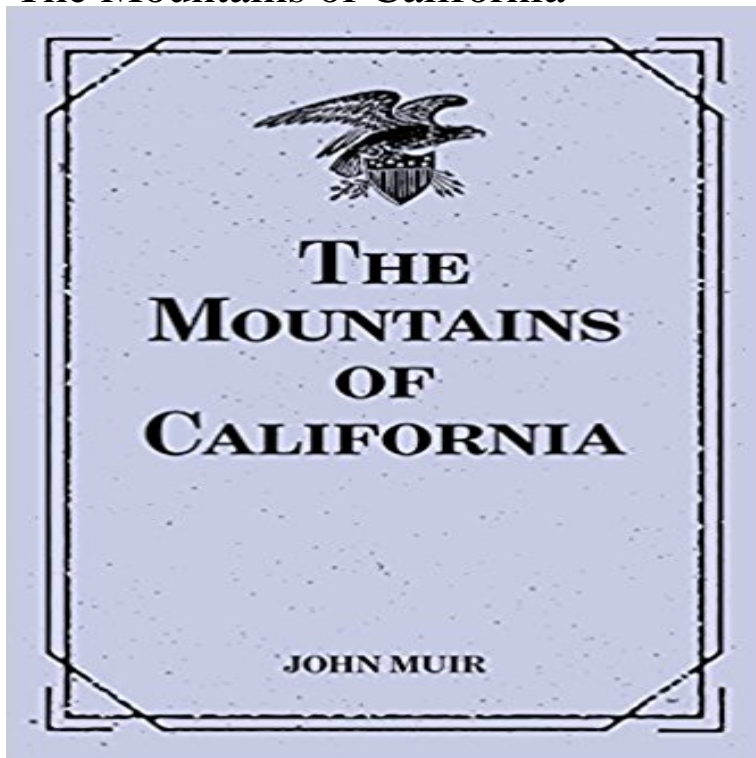


The Mountains of California
